CEDAR BLUE POOL RULES

WARNING-NO LIFE GUARD ON DUTY!

The pool is open from Memorial Day Weekend – Labor Day Weekend Hours/Days: Open Thursday – Tuesday (closed Wednesdays) 10:00 am – 10:00 pm

- Children under 14 <u>MUST</u> be accompanied and supervised by parents or an adult responsible for the child/children.
- Shower using warm water and soap before entering pool.
- Excess body lotions should be removed prior to entering the water.
- Glass containers are prohibited.
- Food, drinks, and smoking are allowed <u>ONLY</u> in the designated area to the north side of the pool bathhouse. These are <u>NOT</u> allowed in any other areas, including the swimming pool, concrete deck and bathhouse.
- Any person suspected of being under the influence or alcohol or drugs shall be prohibited from entering the pool or fenced pool area.
- No street clothes/shorts may be worn in the pool. Wear only bathing suits. Also, please do not wear the same swim suits that you use for the lake as they will contaminate the salt water pool. If this happens, the pool will be shut down for maintenance.
- All infants and toddlers not potty trained are required to wear swim diapers.
 The parasite, Cryptosporidium, and E-Coli 0157 are major health concerns at pools. In case of a fecal deposit in the pool that is loose or a result of diarrhea, the pool will be closed for treatment and will remain closed until water tests indicate it is safe to re-open.
- Persons with cuts, a known/recognizable contagious or communicable disease, cough, cold, open sore
 or wounds, blisters, bandaged wound, fever, inflammation of the eyes, nasal or ear discharges shall not
 be allowed to enter the pool water.
- Spitting, urinating, blowing of the nose, spouting of water or deposit foreign matter in the pool shall be strictly prohibited.
- No person shall bring or throw into the pool, or on the pool decking, walk areas or dressing rooms/showers/restrooms any object that may carry contamination or endanger the safety of any bather.
- No animals are allowed in the pool or fenced pool area.
- No diving into the pool is allowed.
- No rough play or running on the pool deck will be tolerated.
- Use of the pool shall be prohibited during severe weather (i.e., electrical storms, tornadoes, etc.).
- Stay off the rope dividing the pool. If the rope is down, the Health Department can permanently close the pool.

Violation of these rules may result in a \$100 penalty and/or permanent disbarment from the swimming pool.
